Our Recovery Coaches are trained through the Connecticut Community for Addiction Recovery (CCAR) program and Wisconsin certified Peer Support Specialists. They are individuals or affected family members in long-term recovery from substance misuse and/or mental health issues. who want to share their experiences with others in hope that they too may have success in their recovery and healing.
